TechStep: Using Stereo Port Disables Macintosh Speaker

TOPIC -----

I have the Apple TechStep connected to a Macintosh via the audio cable. When I turn on the Macintosh, I don't get the startup tone nor do I get error chimes. Is there a problem?

DISCUSSION -----

Connecting any stereo (audio) cable to the Macintosh stereo port disables the Macintosh speaker, so when you attach Apple TechStep to the Macintosh stereo port, you won't hear either the startup tones or error chimes. This is normal.
